Re: Contract 2022-061 Inmate Health Care Medical Services - Amendment No. 4

The Collin County Sheriff's Office has reviewed the documentation relative to Amendment No. 4 for Contract 2022-061 Inmate Health Care Medical Services. Wellpath's renewal proposal states their intention to make no CPI adjustment to the annual base contract amount, but proposes three optional staffing enhancements, two of which offer a moderate to substantial increase in psychiatric coverage benefitting both the adult and juvenile populations—this proposal for additional psychiatric coverage addresses only existing adult facilities and does not address any potential staffing needs for the Medical/Mental Health building currently under construction. We are satisfied with the County's amendment as it relates to services for the Collin County Adult Detention Facility, but defer to Juvenile Detention as to any decision to modify juvenile services.
