A resolution of the Collin County Commissioners Court in Opposition to the Creation of Collin County Municipal Utility District No. 14

Whereas, the Collin County Commissioners Court received notice of a petition from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality of the proposed Collin County Municipal Utility District No. 14 in accordance with section 54.0161, Tex. Water Code;

Whereas, the Collin County Commissioners Court, pursuant to section 54.0161, Tex. Water Code, may make recommendations regarding the creation of the proposed municipal utility district and submit those recommendations to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality;

Whereas, the Collin County Commissioners Court adopted the Collin County Municipal Utility District and Municipal Management District Policy on May 5, 2025, and the policy requires County staff to review proposed municipal utility district applications and determine whether or not they include the required supplemental contract for police, fire, emergency, and animal control services;

Whereas, if the proposed district does include the required supplemental contract language, then the Commissioners Court will pass a resolution in non-opposition to the proposed district;

Whereas, if the proposed district does not include the required supplemental contract language, then the Commissioners Court will pass a resolution in opposition to the proposed district; and

Whereas, that the proposed district does not include the required supplemental contracts necessary to protect the health and safety of the community.


