The purpose of this announcement is to solicit applications from law enforcement agencies to equip peace officers with rifle-resistant body armor.

How Do You Intend to Utilize The Grant Funding
The agency is requesting rifle rated level III ballistic body armor for patrol deputies and SWAT members.

How Will This Benefit Collin County
This project aligns with evidence-based law enforcement and tactical response practices that emphasize rifle-rated ballistic protection for all personnel operating in high-risk environments. Providing identical rifle-rated body armor to all SWAT-associated personnel and patrol deputies ensures consistent protection, enhances team safety, and eliminates disparities caused by reliance on lower rated ballistic protection armor or personally purchased equipment. Providing needed an required protection also reduces the liability of the county, who must ensure the proper equipment is provided to law enforcement to perform their job safely and effectively.
