Re: Notice of Termination of Teen Court Interlocal Agreement

Dear Mr. Pierson,

In accordance with Section IV of the Teen Court Services Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") between Collin County and the City of Frisco, this letter will serve as notice of Collin County's intent to terminate the Agreement. This decision is the result of the resignation of our Teen Court Coordinator and the unanimous vote by the elected Justices of the Peace for Collin County to discontinue the Collin County Teen Court Program.

As I mentioned during our recent conversation, we will continue to supervise the fifteen juveniles from the City of Frisco for the next sixty (60) days but we will not be accepting any new cases. We had our final Teen Court proceeding on January 14, 2026, and two juvenile respondents referred by the City of Frisco were sentenced to community service hours. We will send completion and non-complete letters to the City of Frisco for all pending juveniles within the next sixty (60) days. Additionally, Collin County will waive the quarterly Basic Charge for January through March 2026 as we continue to supervise the remaining juvenile respondents on our caseload.

Please let me know if you have any further questions and concerns. We look to make this a smooth transition for the City of Frisco.
