Re: Two Contracts for Collin County Jail Electronic Bonds Projects

To date, the county jail's Bonds Office has only been able to accept paper bail bond applications and limited forms of payment for a bail bond. To save time for both staff and the arrested persons, the Sheriff's Office would like to add the ability to 1) accept electronic bail bond applications through an agreement with Genesis eBonds and 2) the ability to accept electronic payments of bond fees through an agreement with Govolution. Cash payments for bond fees would subsequently be added as a function within the current inmate commissary system's capabilities as part the existing Sheriff's Office agreement with Keefe Commissary Network.

The Collin County Sheriff's Office is requesting Commissioners Court approval of the contract with Govolution and the contract of Genesis eBonds. Both contracts have been reviewed/negotiated by Collin County Purchasing and accepted by the Sheriff's Office.
