ASPCA works with Subaru Loves Pets and local Subaru dealerships to assist with preparing animals for adoption as well as assisting the general public with vaccination and microchipping.

How Do You Intend to Utilize The Grant Funding
We will have discounted adoption fees for cats/dogs adopted in the month of October. We will also apply funding to the make-ready costs for cats/dogs available for adoption in October. (Spay/neuter, microchip, vaccinations, testing, deworming). We will also host a vaccination clinic in cooperation with TCAP (Texas Coalition for Animal Protection) on Oct. 3, 2026. We will offer discounted core vaccines and free microchipping to the first 100 animals to attend the event.

How Will This Benefit Collin County
This provides funding to assist with make-ready costs for animals being adopted from CCAS. This also increases awareness for the shelter as well as for vaccinations and microchipping in the community.
