Grant Description The Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation Grant is a funding program that provides financial assistance and lifesaving equipment to first responders and public safety organizations across the United States. The foundation was created by the restaurant chain Firehouse Subs with the goal of improving public safety by ensuring that emergency service agencies have access to the equipment and resources they need to protect their communities.			
How Do You Intend to Utilize The Grant Funding The grant funding will be used to purchase several AEDs to supply each vehicle at the Sheriff's office, enabling the office to be better prepared and more responsive to medical emergencies.			
How Will This Benefit Collin County Funding from this grant would allow the Sheriff's Office to purchase and deploy AEDs in patrol vehicles and key operational areas, ensuring deputies have the necessary tools to respond to cardiac emergencies across the county's large geographic area. Early defibrillation, combined with CPR, significantly increases survival rates for cardiac arrest victims. By equipping deputies with AEDs, the department will be better prepared to stabilize individuals during the first moments of a medical crisis and potentially save lives within the community.
