Anthropic can provide Collin County a Claude Enterprise tenant with \$5k of tokens for 60 days to test success criteria for their potential use cases. There won't be overages at any point. The tenant will stop being queryable at either the 60 day mark or once the \$5k ok tokens has been consumed.

The earliest the county could start is July 13th, as the trial has to be approved by Commissioners Court. The next date would be July 20th.

To move forward with the trial, I need one more thing. Part of submitting this to court is a summary of the trial with specific information. The court wants to know what the trial is for, how long it will last, how much it would cost if we were paying for the service, and, finally, that if the trial runs long, the county will not be billed for any overages.
