Re: Vehicle Losses June 2026

Below, please find vehicle losses for June 2026.

- On June 3, 2026, a Public Works employee was operating a Gradall excavator when he struck a passing vehicle's side mirror and driver's front door. There were no flaggers at the time. No injuries were reported. No repairs were required for the County unit. A claim for the damaged vehicle has been received for \$3,534.95. The vehicle was a work truck, and Risk is working through possible reimbursement for a rental vehicle with an initial estimate of \$7,750.00.
- On June 12, 2026, a Public Works employee was operating a lawn mower when he struck an active telephone pedestal. No injuries were reported. No repairs were required for the County unit. Damage to the telephone pedestal was reported to AT&T, but at this time, we have not received a claim.
- On June 12, 2026, a Public Works employee was operating a lawn mower when he struck a metal grass board. Public Works confirmed that the grass board had been installed approximately two feet inside the County right-of-way (ROW). Because the metal board was located within the County ROW, the County had the right to mow the area. No injuries were reported. No repairs were required for the County unit. No claim has been received for the grass board at this time.
- On June 13, 2026, a Sheriff's Office employee's unit was struck by a citizen who crossed into his lane, causing major damage to the rear left quarter panel and rear left wheel/tire of the County unit. The DPS report indicates that the citizen was driving while intoxicated and was arrested following the accident. The SO employee has filed a workers' compensation claim. Repairs to our unit are estimated at \$23,355.98. This unit is used in an ILA with Lucas. A claim has been submitted to our Third-Party Administrator to pursue subrogation for the cost of repairs and any related workers' compensation expenses.

- On June 18, 2026, a Facilities employee backed up his County unit while the lift platform was inadvertently left open and struck another parked County unit. As a result of the collision, the parked unit sustained damage to the hood, front bumper, and grille. No injuries were reported. Repairs are estimated at \$2,792.17.
- On June 23, 2026, a Public Works employee backed into a guardrail. No injuries were reported. It was determined that no repairs were needed to the County unit or the guardrail.
- On June 26, 2026, a Sheriff's Office employee entered the Service Center to refuel. While turning to access the fuel pumps, he drove over a hedge clipper that he stated was concealed by a pile of leaves. The hedge clipper sustained significant damage and was deemed irreparable. No injuries were reported, and there was no damage to the County unit. The replacement of the hedge clipper is estimated at \$575.99.
- On June 30, 2026, a Sheriff's Office employee pulled into a parking space in the Sally Port, striking a pillar. No injuries were reported. It was determined that repairs will not be completed, as it is due for replacement in FY2027.
