

CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC HEARING

I, the undersigned, hereby certify in connection with the issuance by the Tarrant County Cultural Education Facilities Finance Corporation (the “**Issuer**”) of its hospital revenue bonds pursuant to a plan of financing, in one or more series and in one or more years, in the principal amount not to exceed \$750,000,000 in the aggregate (collectively, the “**Bonds**”), for the benefit of Texas Health Resources, a Texas non-profit corporation, and one or more of its tax-exempt nonprofit affiliates (collectively, the “**System**”), as follows:

2. I conducted such hearing commencing at 10:00 a.m. (Central Standard Time) on Thursday, July 16, 2026, by telephone in the manner described in the notice referred to in paragraph 1 hereof, which was open to the public for purposes of the hearing.

3. At the time for the commencement of the hearing, I publicly requested comments, either orally or in writing, on the facilities to be financed or refinanced with proceeds of the Bonds and on the plan of financing for the issuance of the Bonds.

4. At the hearing, no persons presented comments, orally or in writing.

5. I imposed no time limitations on any public comments.

6. A copy of the minutes of the public hearing is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

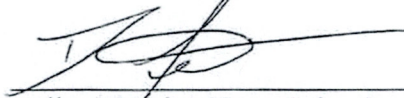

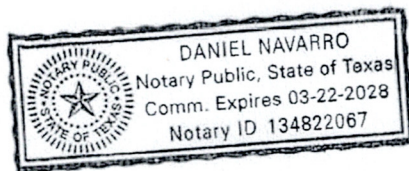
