

A resolution of the Collin County Commissioners Court: Don't Sharia Our Texas

Texas government must stop Sharia Law by declaring that Sharia Law is an incompatible, seditious, subversive, competing enemy system in opposition to the Texas and U.S. Constitutions, and that its advocacy or implementation is a seditious criminal act, deserving disqualification from public, military, and law enforcement service, and justifying criminal punishment, denaturalization, and deportation.

Sharia Law should also be resisted in the following ways:

- **Immigration Reforms:** Formally request that the federal government denaturalize and deport advocates of Sharia Law.
- **No Taxpayer Funds:** Taxpayer funds shall not be granted, contracted, disbursed, or otherwise provided to any entity or program that promotes or advocates allegiance to a foreign legal system – such as Sharia Law – that conflicts with the Constitution of Texas or of the United States; nor shall Texas public schools and taxpayer-funded institutions be permitted to provide meals or services to comply with Sharia Law.
- **Sharia-Compliant Developments:** Stop any residential or non-residential development that advocates the application of Sharia Law or discriminates against those who do not submit to it.
- **Funding Prohibitions:** Stop religious and educational institutions in Texas from receiving funding from hostile foreign or domestic sources that have any affiliation with any organization that advocates Sharia Law or has been designated as a Foreign Terror Organization (FTO) or Transnational Criminal Organization (TCO).
- **Enforce and Expand Our Laws:** Enforce Texas sedition laws against the advocacy of Sharia Law, and rigorously enforce other Texas laws that already criminalize aspects of Sharia Law, such as terroristic threat, female genital mutilation, animal cruelty, domestic violence, rape, polygamy, and pedophilia; modify existing statutes to explicitly reference Sharia inclusion; expand the jurisdiction of the Office of the Attorney General to prosecute such laws; eliminate taxpayer assistance to women who in reality are wives under Sharia Law; and enact legislation to eliminate the fraud related to Sharia-compliant financing.
- **Expand American Law For American Courts (ALAC):** Expand the legal applications of the American Law for American Courts (HB 45, 85R) and adopt a Texas Domestic Terrorist Organization Designation Act to define and prohibit domestic terrorists and sponsors of terror; create a private civil cause of action

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allowing RICO (Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations) provisions to be pursued by victims of terrorism.

We hereby support these initiatives and encourage the Texas Legislature to adopt these objectives in the 90th legislature.

A motion was made, seconded, and carried by a majority of the court members in attendance during a regular session on Monday, August 17, 2026.
