

A resolution of the Collin County Commissioners Court: Ban Taxpayer-Funded Lobbying

Prohibit all forms of taxpayer-funded lobbying by any taxing entity, including the use of tax dollars to hire lobbyists, direct use contractors, third parties, and non-elected public employees who are registered lobbyists; prohibit associations or other entities that receive tax dollars and also collect premiums, dues, fees, or subscriptions from engaging in any lobbying activities; establish civil and criminal penalties, including enforcement by local prosecutors and the Texas Attorney General, for using taxpayer funds to lobby.

We hereby support these initiatives and encourage the Texas Legislature to adopt these objectives in the 90th legislature.

A motion was made, seconded, and carried by a majority of the court members in attendance during a regular session on Monday, August 17, 2026.
